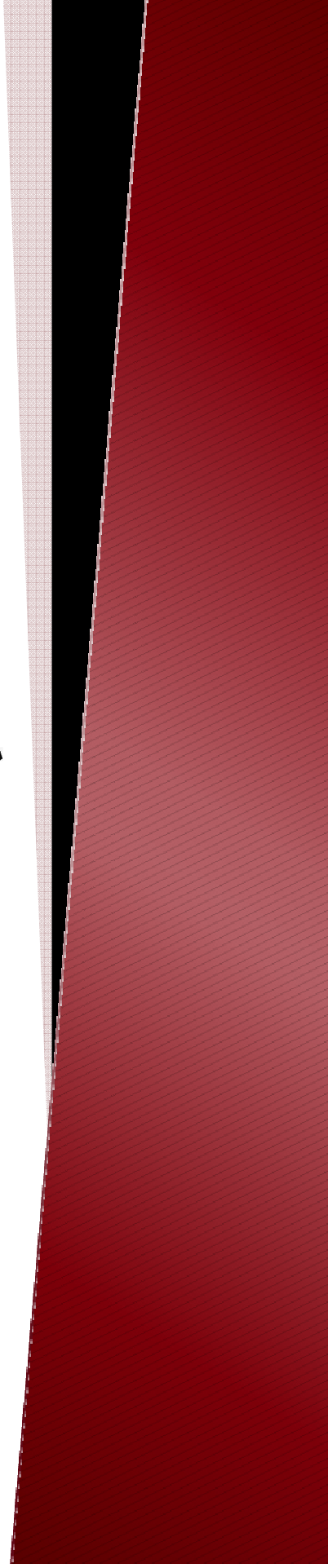
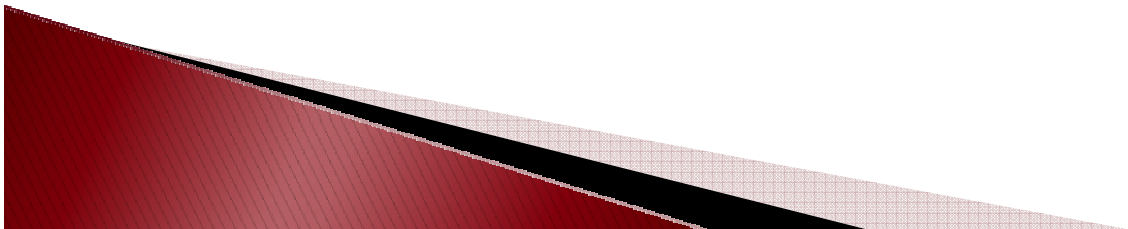

Gentry District ACSIP Priorities

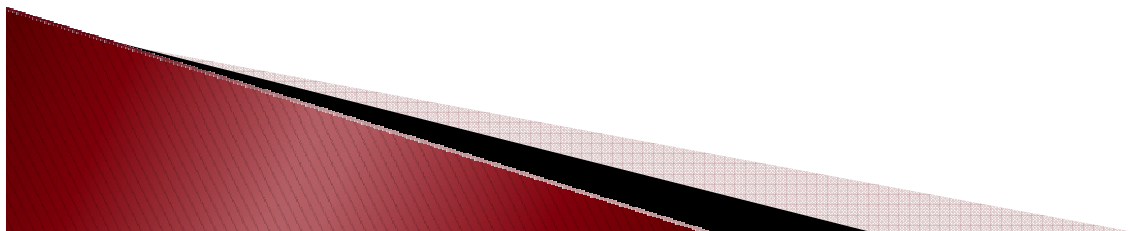
- Priority 1 – Extended Use of Federal and State Funds

Priority 1 – Extended Use of Federal and State Funds

Goal – Improved performance to the proficiency level in literacy and math

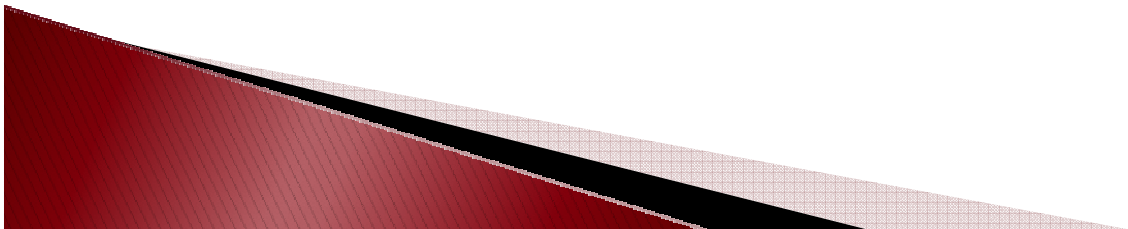
- Technology – hardware and software purchases and upgrades

Priority 2 – Safe and Drug Free Schools

Goal – Students in Gentry will have the opportunity for a safe, violence and drug free environment that is conducive to learning and allows them to succeed.

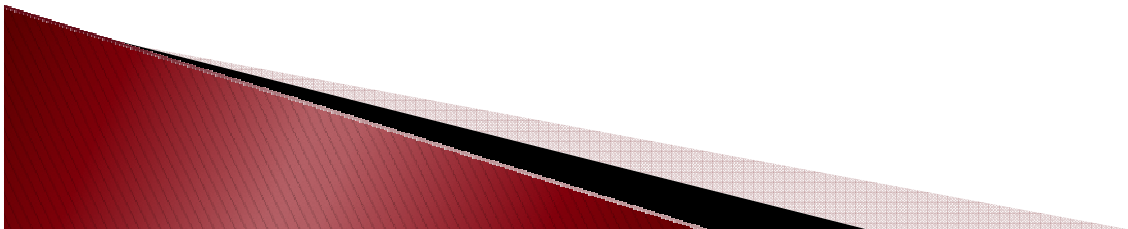
- Continue to employ a school resource officer (SRO) in conjunction with the City of Gentry Police Department
- Support drug free and character development activities for each school in the district



Priority 3 – Health and Wellness

Goal – Gentry Public Schools recognizes each child as a unique individual. Our goal is to help every child develop the skills to become healthy, fit, and responsible citizens.

- Continue to follow the local wellness policy as well as state and federal rules and regulations regarding child nutrition and physical activity
- Encourage development and participation in family oriented, community-based physical activity
- Employ a licensed nurse for each campus



Priority 4 – Title III – English Language Learners

Goal – The district will support the schools in the improvement of literacy and math of all ELL students.

- Allocation of funds to employ two certified *English as a Second Language* (ESL) teachers
- Allocation of funds to employ a paraprofessional to provide services to our ELL students at the primary school
- Allocation of funds to purchase needed materials, supplies, educational aides to promote academic gains for ELL students
